PUBLIC SECTOR STATUS, APPLICABILITY OF BNA & GUARANTEE OF FWBL'S DEPOSITS BY THE GOVERNMENT UNDER BNA 1974



The Government of Pakistan vide its letter No. F. 6(2) -DS (BR-II) 2000-355 dated 10 June, 2011 has exempted FWBL from the application of the Office Memorandum No. F.4. (1)/2000-BR-II, dated 12 November, 2002. Under the said office memo, Government laid down certain requirements to be complied with by public sector enterprises and local/autonomous bodies while depositing their working balances for their operations with any public or private bank. This exemption will come into effect immediately.


