HAZRAT KHADIJA TUL KUBRA GOLD MEDAL AWARDED TO MRS. SHAFQAT SULTANA, PRESIDENT FWBL





The Pakistan Federation of Business & Professional Women Organization (BPW) conferred the Hazrat Khadija Tul Kubra Gold Medal on Mrs. Shafqat Sultana, President/CEO and Chairperson of FWBL, for her outstanding performance in the field of banking. The ceremony was held in Lahore recently. Mrs. Shafqat Sultana, President/CEO and

Chairperson of the Board of Directors of FWBL, is a prudent banker and achiever par excellence. She has about 37 years of banking service to her credit, out of which she has dedicated 22 long years to First Women Bank Ltd.

She was appointed as the President of First Women Bank Ltd. in the year 2009. Soon after taking charge, Mrs. Sultana made every effort to restore the public sector status of the Bank. In the same year, she succeeded in her mission when the Government decided to keep FWBL as a public sector bank.

Having done her Master's in Political Science from the University of Peshawar, Mrs. Sultana started her banking career as an Officer at United Bank Ltd. in 1975. She was designated the first Lady Manager at the PC branch Rawalpindi in 1988.

She joined First Women Bank Ltd. in 1990 as a Branch Manager in the AVP cadre, and was awarded the best Branch Manager award for two consecutive years. Besides this, she used her expertise in the training & development of

women entrepreneurs and served as the National Project Director - Women in Urban Credit, a joint project of UNDP and FWBL. She was eventually promoted to the rank of EVP in 2002 and then President of the Bank.

She has been a keynote speaker at numerous national and international forums. Mrs. Sultana has been the recipient of the Best Sector Executive Award, Excellence Award from Laurels of Honor - 2009, Woman of the Year Award - 2009, Lifetime Achievement Award - 2010 and Wonder Woman of the Year Award - 2011, etc. She also holds to her credit many publications as well.

In 2011, Newsweek Pakistan included her name in the list of top 100 women who shake Pakistan.

Every two years BPW (Business Professional Women) awards deserving women for their achievements in the name of Hazrat Khadija Tul Kubra, the revered first wife of the Holy Prophet (PBUH) who herself was a working woman and a role model for all womenfolk.

FWBL CELEBRATES 23 YEARS OF WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT



The ceremony started off with the recitation of the Holy Quran by Ms. Sarah Moeen. Mrs. Shafqat Sultana, President, in her welcoming speech said that First Women Bank Ltd. has a mandate for improving the socio-economic condition of women by providing employment opportunities to women of low and middle income groups.

She said that since its inception, the Bank had been concerned about the fact that operational results should meet the aspirations of entrepreneurs and national objectives. "We currently have 600 employees and in 1989 we were only 30. Our Deposit base was Rs. 79 million and today our Deposits have touched Rs. 15 billion. In 1989, Advances were Rs. 5 million and today they have crossed Rs. 10 billion. In 1989, women entrepreneurs were few in number and mostly associated with traditional business - today a number of our customers have graduated from running small to medium enterprises and the growth continues," she underlined.

She further stated that in the year 1989 women bankers were 1% of the total bankers, and today the percentage has significantly increased to 10%. Mrs. Sultana said that FWBL has 41 branches in 24 cities across Pakistan, adding that more branches will be opened in more cities.

The FWBL model has been replicated in Tanzania, Iran, Iraq and other parts of the world, saying that big players of the banking industry in Pakistan were also implementing the idea by opening women branches and women empowerment cells in their institutions. She thanked the Government of Pakistan, State Bank of Pakistan and FWBL's Board of Directors for their continued support and guidance.

Begum Salma Ahmed, Vice President FPCCI, Mr. Majyd Aziz, Chairman, SME Bank and noted writer Haseena Moin in their speeches appreciated the role of the Bank. Mr. Sameer Zaheer, a valued FWBL customer also shared his experience with the Bank. The program was conducted by Ms. Shaheen Zamir, Head of Marketing, PR & Entrepreneurship Development.




