FWBL POSTED RECORD PERFORMANCE IN 2011

The Board of Directors met under the Chairmanship of Mrs. Shafqat Sultana in Karachi to review the annual performance of the Bank and approved the financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2011.

The financial year 2011 proved to be a year of record performance for FWBL, as it posted PKR 400 million profits as compared to PKR 54.7 million in 2010. Deposits were PKR 13,815 million as compared to PKR 10,195 million last year. Advances were PKR 7,901 million at December 31, 2011, showing an increase of PKR 1,365 million. Shareholders' Equity has increased to PKR 1,720 million as compared to PKR 1,106 million in 2010. Earnings Per Share (EPS) as of December 31, 2011 came to PKR 0.30 for the last year.

Khari irrigation valve to generate electricity. In lieu of this, WAPDA has advised the company to install some extra parts and equipment to mitigate the water hammer and stress in the Jari tunnel, which is their main water source for which they had approached FWBL for a finance facility for a 6 year duration. This finance facility has enabled them to successfully achieve their desired purpose, that is the generation of electricity, and has supported their associated project, Mangla Metals (Pvt) Ltd.

MAHRAJA ENTERPRISE (PVT) LTD.





BD & TC KARACHI & LAHORE FWBL - GEP (Gender Equity Program) Women's Economic Empowerment through Capacity Building & Skill Development

FWBL is committed to the goal of realizing the potential of women who require assistance in enhancing their access to entrepreneurial activities and formal employment. It is also committed to Pakistan's national and international commitments, highlighted in the Beijing Platform for Action, 1995; the National Plan of Action for Women, 1998 and the National Policy for the Development & Empowerment of Women.

The Bank is implementing a two year pilot program through its Business Development & Training Centers (BD & TC) located in Karachi & Lahore, under the Gender Equity Program (GEP) of the Aurat Foundation, supported by the American people through USAID. Under this program, the Aurat Foundation has awarded a grant of Rs. 13.8 million to First Women Bank Ltd. for a period of 2 years. GEP is a 5 year program, implemented in Pakistan by the Aurat Foundation in collaboration with 'The Asia Foundation', to serve the cause of women's empowerment and advancement in the country.

The main objectives of the Program are:

- To enhance women's entrepreneurial development and employability through capacity building and skill development
- 2. To provide trainings in core subjects related to women's entrepreneurship/employment
- To facilitate access to loans through FWBL to successful trainees for initiating entrepreneurial activity

Free training will be given to women of low income groups in traditional & non-traditional areas, including Multimedia Graphic Design, Hair & Beauty, Fashion Design, Embroidery Design using CAD, House Keeping, Cookery, etc. BD & TC has designed a Market Survey Form to get feedback from women to improve and enhance its areas of training.

The Bank has made arrangements with top institutes of the country to achieve its objectives. Advertisements will be placed in the newspaper and on the website of the Bank. BD & TC are also inviting applications through NGOs. A transparent program is being adopted by the Bank with an aim to provide quality education to the most deserving women.

Expected Deliverables:

- Approximately 640 women will acquire entrepreneurial skills
- Nearly 320 women will set-up and run their own businesses
- All 640 women will be facilitated and made probable to access loans through FWBL
- Employability of trained women will be facilitated
- Trained women entrepreneurs will be connected to the Women's Chamber of Commerce/Chambers of Commerce, SMEDA, TDAP, etc.
